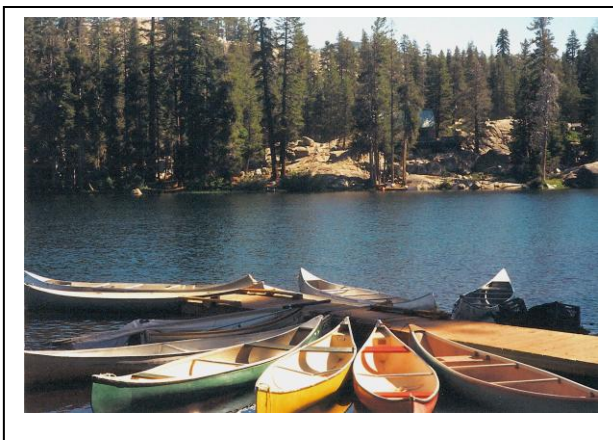

***BEGINNING BACKPACKING***



**WANDERERS** \$435

Grades 7 thru 10

No experience needed, just an interest in hiking. Capture the magic of the mountains as you carry your own gear on a 3-day, 2-night hike through the High Sierra mountains. Learn the basics of backpacking. Must be in good physical condition.. Catch the thrill of sleeping under the stars!. Campers provide their own packs and boots.

*Minimum camper weight 75 lbs.*



**ROVERS** \$435

Grades 8 thru 12

Some backpacking experience recommended. Lace up your boots, fill your water bottle and hike the Sierra Nevada mountains on a 4-day, 3-night backpacking trip. Campers provide their own packs and boots.

*Minimum camper weight 85 lbs.*

***ADVANCED BACKPACKING***

Attendance at one in-town meeting or consultation with staff by camper and parent is required prior to camp to check gear and to finalize plans.



**TREKKERS** \$765

*Only 2<sup>nd</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup> Sessions*

Grades 9 thru 12

Challenge yourself on a 7-day 6-night backpacking trek. A perfect transition between Rovers and Superpackers.

Campers provide their own packs and boots. Backpacking experience required.

*Minimum camper weight 90 lbs.*



**SUPERPACKERS** \$795

*Only 1<sup>st</sup> thru 2<sup>nd</sup> Sessions*

Grades 10 thru 12

Experience the ultimate in alpine adventures on an 11-day backpack trip in the High Sierra. Campers provide their own packs and boots. This trip is for experienced packers. Girls without prior Two Sentinels backpacking experience **must** be approved by directors. Two Sentinels Superpacker hooded sweatshirt included in cost.

**ONE STEP BEYOND (OSB) Counselor Training Program**

**This is a Two-Session Commitment \$470**

For young women grades 11-12 and beyond. Discover your leadership potential...enhance your skills in group dynamics, communication, child development, camp craft, delivery of camp program and camp operations. **Our Site:** Imagine spending your days around a lake that reflects the startling blue skies and tall pine trees of the Sierra mountains. Located on the shores of Lake Kirkwood, Two Sentinels is nestled in the granite cascades at an elevation of 8000 feet. Surrounded by miles of wilderness trails, our camp is situated in a rustic, secluded setting 30 miles south of Lake Tahoe.

**Campers sleep in tents or buildings among the trees and under the stars. Each day is filled with a variety of camp activities in this unique, beautiful Girl Scout camp where generations of girls have been gathering since 1936. Our site also offers hot showers and great food.**

**Our Campers:** Our campers are Girl Scouts and non-Girl Scouts alike; entering grades 4 through 12 in the fall of 2012. From brand new campers to the old pros, every smiling face makes up the fabric of singing, exploring, fun and friendship that is camp life. Acceptance and participation is without regard to color, race, religion, economic background, or national origin.

**Our Staff:** Camp Two Sentinels is staffed with creative, enthusiastic, well-trained adult volunteers from many Bay Area Girl Scout associations. We are troop leaders, moms, caring adults and specially trained young adult staff. Our counselor to camper ratio is 1:4.

**Our Program:** Geared toward promoting self-esteem in a rustic setting, our program includes **swimming, canoeing, funyaking, sailing, hiking, backpacking, archery, cookouts, campfires, arts and crafts, nature, astronomy, games, singing, and optional badge earning.** Our progressive program is planned to keep girls and their counselors interested from ages 9 to 90!

Our youngest campers experience all the magic of being in the Sierra in a safe and comfortable setting. Older girls can choose to continue their in camp fun in our Docker, Gypsy or Pioneer unit. They can also choose to branch out and join our backpacking units.

Two Sentinels is renowned for our graduated backpacking program. Our youngest packers start with a one-day experience. Interested older campers may choose to join backpacking units that gradually build strength, skill, and stamina on increasingly challenging trips. Our ultimate backpacking challenge is met by campers with advanced skills and experience on an amazing 11-day trek!
